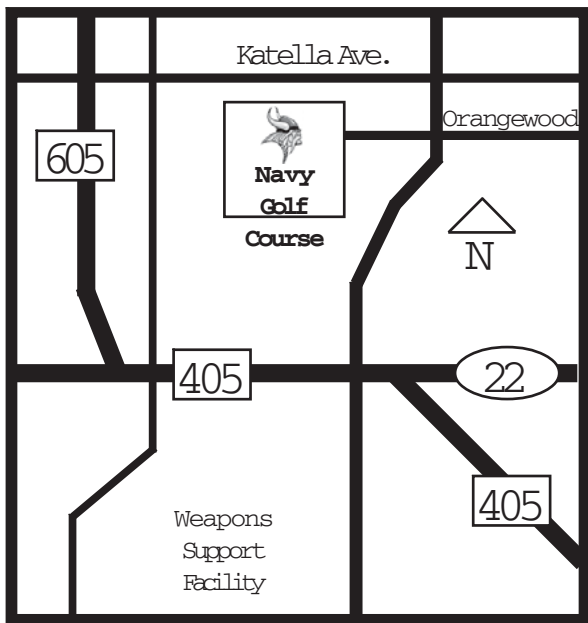

This year we can accommodate 144 golfers. Please send checks by May 1. Meet this deadline and your name will go into a drawing for a special raffle item. Your check(s) will confirm your reservation(s). If capacity is not reached by May 7, walk-ins will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

This tournament will feature a Scramble Format with **FOUR-PERSON TEAMS**, headed by a team captain. There will be three men's flights (Championship, "A" and "B"), a co-ed flight (two or three women on a team), and a women's flight. There will be first and second place trophies for all flights. Teams will be required to select each team member's tee shot a minimum of three times during the round. Men will be hitting from the white tees and women from the red tees. Special rules to speed play will be in operation.

Team or individual reservations may be submitted. Preference will be given to teams, so it is advisable to enter in that fashion. **(Acceptance will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis with the submittal of the entry fee as the confirmation.)** Actual donation to LBCC Foundation, Athletic Associates is \$85 per person. You will receive a receipt in accordance with tax laws.

2009 Honorees:
Don & Carol Maloney

Long-time Long Beach residents and LBCB supporters Don and Carol Maloney are this year's Long Beach City College Foundation Athletic Associates Golf Tournament honorees.

The Maloneys have been part of the Long Beach sports scene since the family relocated from Adrian, Michigan in 1960.

Don and Carol became actively involved in sports at Long Beach Poly High School. Don served as president of the Poly High School booster club for six years in the 1970s while Carol was a member of the PTA. For their efforts, he and Carol were co-recipients of the Medallion of Merit Award for their continuous support. Don and Carol were the first couple to ever earn the award.

In 1995, Don helped establish the Long Beach City College Viking Huddle Club. He served as president for three seasons and was actively involved for six years.

A member of the Long Beach Century Club, Don received the Tom & Georgie Gleason Award from the Century Club in 1998. The award is given to recognize constant encouragement and support of Long Beach athletic achievements.

Don and Carol were both gracious when talking about being honored by the Athletic Associates.

"I think it's a great honor," said Don. "But at the time we were more interested in helping out the kids and the program. We were never looking for recognition. It was a great time to be involved."

"We both feel honored," said Carol. "It was really thoughtful of the committee to select us."

Don and Carol will celebrate their 60th wedding anniversary this November. They have four children and five grandchildren. Don was quick to praise his wife Carol for being by his side.

"She's been my partner in everything we've done," he said. "She's a great right arm. I've been blessed to have her with me."
